Steps to a Relationship With Christ

A step by step guide to accept Christ as your Lord and Savior

Step 1: Understand WHY God created us

God created us because He LOVES us and wants us to ENJOY a personal relationship with him.

"Even before the world was made, God had already chosen us to be His through our union with Christ . . . because of His love, God had already decided that through Jesus Christ he would make us His children - this was God's pleasure and purpose." Ephesians 1:4-5

Step 2: See the benefits of shifting into real LIFE

When we KNOW and LOVE God, and LIVE according to God's purpose for our lives, it produces tremendous benefits in our lives.

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

John 10:10

Step 3: Admit you're not perfect

HOWEVER, there is a problem! You already know what that problem is, no one is perfect! And the Bible calls that imperfection "sin." Sin means we are separate from God. Imperfection results in a consequence; and that consequence is eternal separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23

Step 4: Know that a relationship with God requires perfection

God is perfect and we are imperfect. The only way for us to enjoy a relationship is for us to be perfect ourselves--but nobody is perfect!

Step 5: Believe that Jesus died for our sins and rose from the dead

HOWEVER, God came to earth as Jesus to lead a perfect life and to PAY the price of OUR imperfection! Why did God do this? Why did God send His son to die in our place? Because He loves us so much He did EVERYTHING to restore the relationship with imperfect people. Jesus freely offers this gift through faith in him.

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

"Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures..." 1 Corinthians 15:1-4

Step 6: Publicly confess Christ as your Lord and Savior

Once you believe in Jesus Christ and what He has done for you. It is time to shout it from the rooftops. Come and stand before you church family and share your confession that Christ is your Lord and Savior.

"Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven." Matthew 10:32

Step 7: Become a new creation in Christ through baptism

Now that you have publicly confessed Christ as your Lord and Savior, follow Jesus' example and be baptized by a believer. The water is not Holy, but through the act of obedience Christ gives us the gift of the Holy Spirit and forgiveness of our sins. Our old self is washed away and we are made into new creations in Christ.

"Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" Acts 2:38

"What this means is that those who become Christians become new persons. They are not the same anymore, for the old life is gone. A new life has begun!" 2 Corinthians 5:17

Step 8: Begin living your new life in Christ to the fullest

After your have accepted Jesus' free gift of salvation, setting him apart as Lord and Savior of your life, it's now time to celebrate your new live in Christ. Throw away the old and celebrate the new

"What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? By no means! We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?" Romans 6:1-2

Step 9: Remain Faithful

Now that you have experienced the new life Christ offers, stay close to him. Know that temptation will still come, but take refuge in the hope of Christ

Forgiveness: Can't Leave Home Without It

1. NO ONE IS PERFECT, WE'VE ALL FELT GUILTY OVER SOMETHING WE'VE DONE

"...for all have sinned (imperfect) and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

2. GOD IS PERFECT, AND OUR IMPERFECTION CAN'T SURVIVE IN HIS PRESENCE

God's forgiveness washes away our imperfection and ALLOWS us to have a relationship with God.

3. FORGIVENESS IS POSSIBLE BECAUSE GOD LOVES US AND SENT HIS SON, JESUS, TO PAY THE PRICE OF OUR IMPERFECTION.

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

4. BECAUSE OUR FORGIVENESS COMES FROM GOD, OUR SALVATION IS SECURE AND UNSHAKABLE.

There's nothing anyone can do to keep us from God's forgiveness.

"For I am convinced that neither death nor life, angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:38-39

1. GOD HAS A PLAN HE CUSTOM TAILORED FOR EVERYONE

Every believer has a special part to play, that God has designed for us before we were born.

Hope: How the Future Is Secure

1. HOPE: OUR PERCEPTION OF HOW THE FUTURE WILL TURN OUT.

2. THE HOPE WE BELIEVER'S HAVE IS SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT FROM ANYTHING NON-BELIEVERS CAN HOPE IN.

"In those days you were living apart from Christ. You were excluded from God's people, Israel, and you did not know the promises God had made to them. You lived in this world without God and without hope." Ephesians 2:12

"And now, brothers and sisters, I want you to know what will happen to the Christians who have died so you will not be full of sorrow like people who have no hope." 1 Thessalonians 4:13

3. THE HOPE GOD OFFERS CAN'T BE CHANGED OR ALTERED

Accepting Christ has changed your life, and it can change the lives of your non-believing friends. YOU DON'T HAVE TO HAVE ALL THE ANSWERS to talk about Jesus. All you have to share is the life change you've experienced.
